The Sermon on the Mount: Are We the Lord's Fans or Followers?

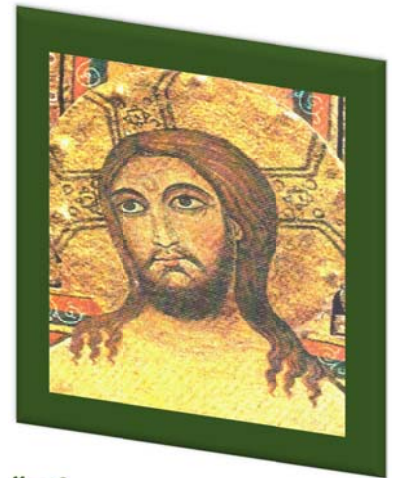

Directions to Our Lady of the Angels Convent are as follows:

**From Lubbock, Brownfield Highway, or Highway 114**

Travel south on Upland (CR 1600) until it dead-ends at Woodrow Road.

Turn right onto Woodrow Road and proceed west for 2 miles

to County Road 1440 (Just after the housing development "Southwest Vistas").

Make a left turn (south) on CR 1440, a caliche road. Continue one mile on this road to County Road 7700.

Make a left turn onto CR 7700 – and then another left into the convent driveway.

**From Seminole, Seagraves, Brownfield**

In Ropesville, turn right onto Highway 41. Continue on #41 to Highway 179. Turn left on #179.

At Woodrow Road, turn right.

After about a mile, turn right (south) on County Road 1440 (a caliche road).

Continue on this road to County Road 7700.

Make a left turn onto CR 7700 – and then another left into the convent driveway.

**From US 87 (I-27):**

Exit at Woodrow Road. Go west on Woodrow Road.

Continue on Woodrow Road to County Road 1440 (Just after the housing development "Southwest Vistas").

Make a left turn (south) on CR 1440, a caliche road. Continue on this road to County Road 7700.

Make a left turn onto CR 7700 – and then another left into the convent driveway.
